

FREDERICK ALBERT HUTCHINSON

15.11.1911–15.6.1944 aged 33 years

Private 4982596 2nd Battalion West Yorkshire Regiment



Frederick worked in the building industry prior to the outbreak of World War II. He lived at 33 Nottingham Road with his wife, Doris *nee* Davis and had one daughter, Audrey. He served in the Far East fighting the Japanese and was killed in action near Rangoon. He was wounded and incapacitated and whilst in the process of being evacuated on a stretcher by medics he was run through with bayonets by attacking Japanese infantry. He has no known grave and is recorded on the Rangoon Memorial face 8.
