Sidney lived with his parents, William and Nellie Hardy at 98 Nottingham Road and worked at the Derbyshire's Gypsum Mine before the war. He served in Italy. He was killed not in action, but in a fall from a balcony in Rome. Rome was liberated on the 4th of June 1944. He is buried in Rome CWGC cemetery Row II D 14.
