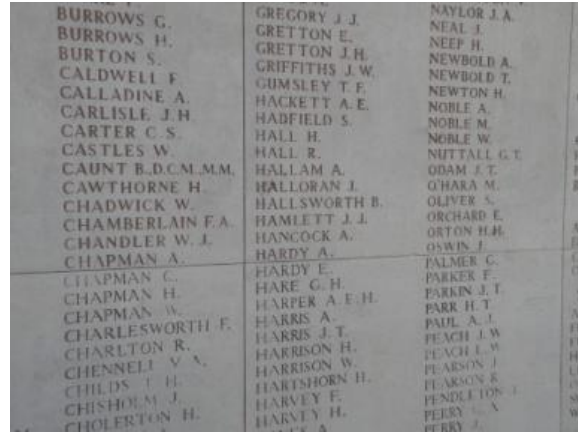


ALBERT HALLAM

1889-9.8.15 aged 26 years

Private 4036 2nd Battalion Sherwood Foresters



Albert was born in Gotham, the son of Henry and Mary Hallam, and husband of Clara, *nee* Hudson. They had one child, Harry born in 1913. Albert was a Territorial Army reservist and at the outbreak of war was living in Parr's Yard, St Peter's Street, Nottingham and his parents had moved to Bosworth Road, Meadows. Albert was killed in action during an attack on Sanctuary Wood, Ypres. The Methodist Roll states that he died of wounds received at Hooge, which is at odds with no known grave and in conflict with the Sanctuary Wood location given by the Sherwood Foresters Museum. He has no known grave and is recorded on the Menin Gate memorial panel 39/41.
