

## **HENRY STRUTT**

**1894–25.5.1915 aged 21 years**

**Able Seaman KX/229 Howe Battalion RNVR**



Henry was a reservist, who like many sailors, was called upon to form infantry battalions as there were more sailors than ships in World War I. He was the son of Henry and Elizabeth Strutt of Gladstone Avenue, one of five children. He is buried in the Alexandria (Chatby) CWGC cemetery Egypt row M 124. The location and date suggest he may have been wounded in the Gallipoli campaign.
