

LUTHER PEPPER

15.10.11–27.5.1940 aged 29 years

Private 5045895 2nd Battalion North Staffordshire Regiment.



Luther was the son of Theophilus Pepper and was married to Ada. He was a regular soldier before the outbreak of World War II, but was called back to the colours from his job at the Royal Ordnance Factory Nottingham. He was killed in action in the BEF's retreat to Dunkirk in 1940. He is buried in the Kommiens communal cemetery plot 24.
